Project	Funding Source	Progress as of 20th November 2019
Wave 2	NHSE	The 12 NHS Trusts in the programme had on-boarded almost 400 new volunteers in high impact roles (e.g. mobility, mealtime, end of life, discharge), have supported 3,535 patients, and given 2,174 hours.
End of Life Care	Sowerby / Marie Curie/ NLCF	7 projects now agreed with funding from NCLF Sowerby Trust Marie Curie Scottish project is funded by NCLF and first meeting of the project group has taken place in Borders.
Sustainable and Transformative Partnership (STP)	NHSE STP	Helpforce has just started a project with NHSE on integrated approaches to volunteering 44 Trusts have joined this project which is in the early stages of planning
Scaling	NHSE	Helpforce is starting to spread and scale volunteering initiatives starting with the spreading of Response Volunteers. A How to adopt and spread this innovation has been drafted
UK expansion	Core	Helpforce has expanded its projects outside of England with 1 project running in Scotland 1 in Northern Ireland and 3 in Wales (2 are funded by the Welsh Government)
Education Training	HEE	The UK wide Project exploring the culture and support of clinical staff towards volunteers is ongoing and we are working with senior nurses in Scotland to progress this work in Scotland.
