Volunteering Information System: Board report

1. Introduction

This paper provides the National Group for Volunteering in NHSScotland a more detailed report from the 2018/19 data in the Volunteering Information System. At the October 2019 meeting the Group requested sight of data on a board by board basis. The national 2018/19 report can be found [here](#).

All data in this report accurate as of **4 October 2019**.

The Volunteering Information System is used by 18 NHS Boards: Golden Jubilee Hospital (NWTC), Healthcare Improvement Scotland, NHS 24, NHS Ayrshire & Arran, NHS Borders, NHS Dumfries and Galloway, NHS Education for Scotland, NHS Fife, NHS Forth Valley, NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde, NHS Health Scotland, NHS Highland, NHS Lanarkshire, NHS Lothian, NHS Shetland, NHS Tayside, NHS Western Isles, The State Hospitals Board for Scotland.

NHS Grampian, NHS National Services Scotland, NHS Orkney and the Scottish Ambulance Service do not currently use the system.

A number of caveats accompany the data in this report:

- (a)** Some national bodies, such as Healthcare Improvement Scotland do not undertake ongoing volunteer recruitment, rather, will have specific windows of opportunity resulting in sparse data for long periods of time.
- (b)** One part of NHS Fife (Victoria Hospice) does not use the Volunteering Information System.
- (c)** Some volunteer managers/Volunteering Information System users do not log all enquiries, instead undertaking an initial 'filtering' of enquiries that are often signposted on. As a result, real figures are expected to be far higher.
- (d)** Arrangements in some boards differ where there is a third sector organisation involved in day to day volunteer management. E.g. the children's hospital in NHS Lothian is included whilst the same in NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde is not.

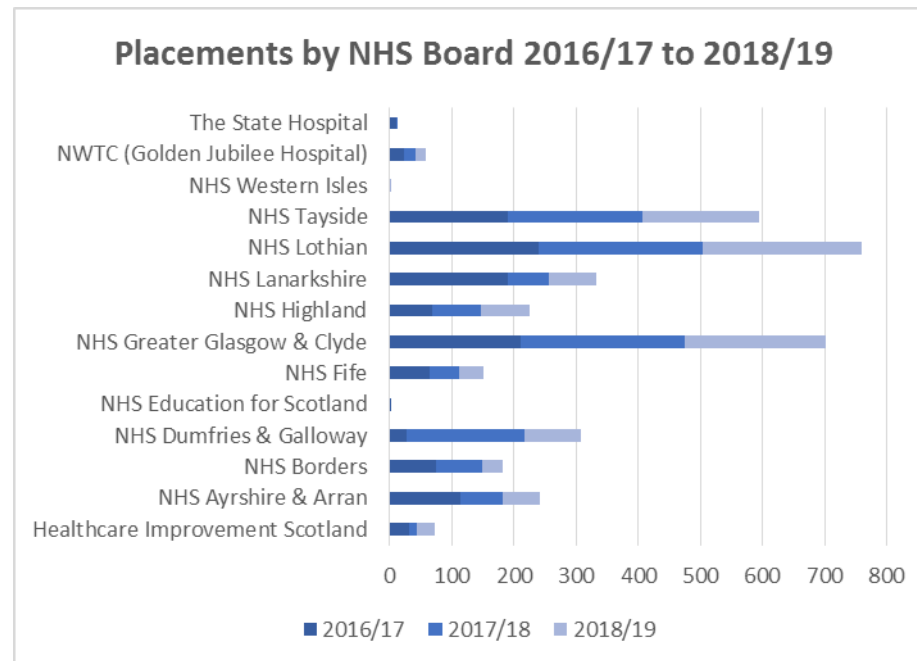

Key points:

- ▶ A number of volunteer managers (Volunteering Information System users) report that they do not log every enquiry in the system due to an initial filtering process (often by telephone) which seeks to ascertain the applicant's viability to volunteer in the defined roles and their expectations from doing so. As a result the conversion rate (as of 4 Oct) of 43.7% is an **underestimation of the national picture**.
- ▶ Inactive volunteers are those who have begun a placement in 2018/19 but have taken time out from volunteering as of 4 October 2019.

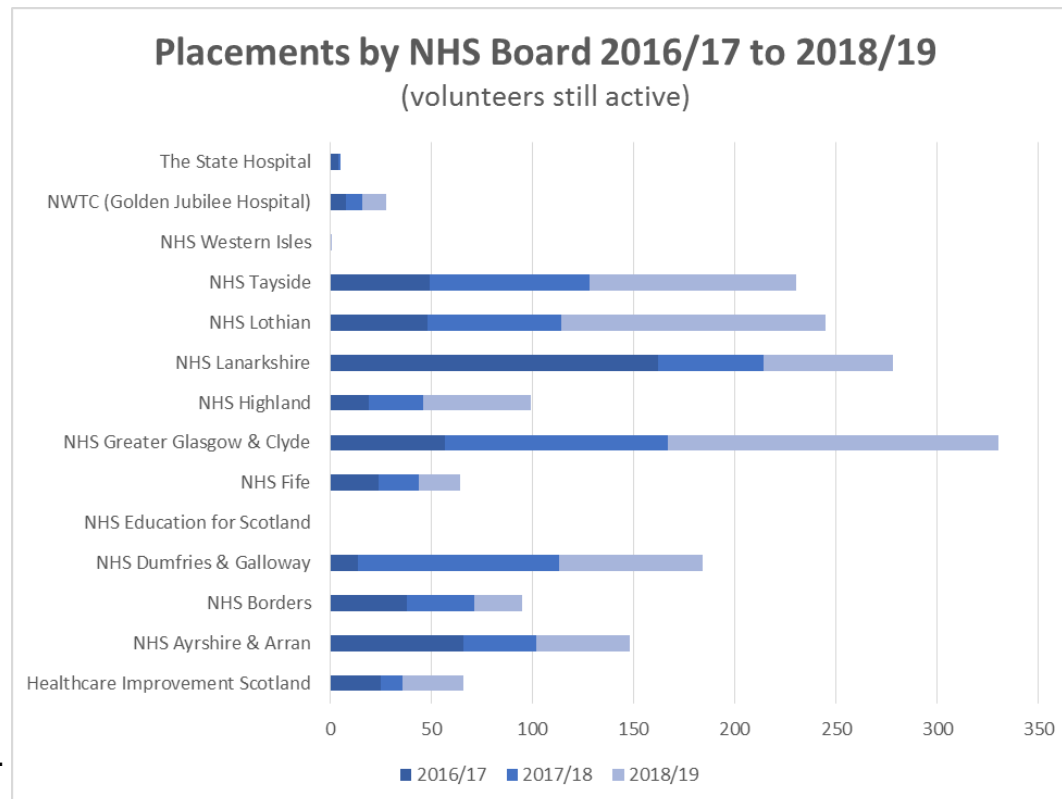
