
List below the broad service user steps:

(These are steps that the service user experiences (i.e. what they see, feel or hear) rather than the steps that only the service provider experiences)

- 1. Pre-assessment
- 2. Arrive at Day of Surgery Assessment Unit (DOSA)
- 3. Go through theatre checklist with healthcare staff members
- 4. Arrive at the anaesthetic room
- 5. Transfer to theatre room
- 6. Recover in recovery room
- 7. Discharge or Transfer to ward or Day Surgery Unit

| Journey touchpoint | Discovery questions (1-2 per touchpoint) | Digging deeper questions |

| Pre-assessment | Talk me through what happened on the day of your pre-assessment. | What happened when you arrived? Who did you meet and what did they do and say? What did that feel like? |
| Arrive at DOSA | Tell me about what happened when you met the surgery nurse following pre-assessment? | What about that meeting felt important?Was there anything that you felt confused about? |
| Healthcare worker (theatre checklist) | What was it like completing the surgical checklist with them? | Who went through the checklist with you?How did it feel? |
| Anaesthetic room | Walk me through what happened when you were transferred to the anaesthetic room. | What were you thinking then?What mattered most to you about that time? |
| Theatre Room | What do you remember about going for surgery? What was it like arriving in the theatre room? | Who spoke to you there? What did they tell you? Tell me about what you remember happening? What was important to you about that? How did you feel? |
| Recovery Room | Tell me about the time you spent in recovery. | What mattered to you most whilst you were there? Was there anything difficult about that experience? How would you describe it to a member of your family or a friend? |
| Discharge / Transfer | What happened when you heard you were about to be discharged/ transferred? | How did you feel about that?What did you need most at that point? |
